- Why is your idea better or different than others?
- ➤ What makes your project unique or special?
- Who will benefit from your project?
- ➤ How will people, animals or nature be helped?
- What do you need to make it happen?
- ➤ Money? Support? People? Technology?
- What will happen if you don't get support?
- ➤ Why is it important to act now?
